3. **AURORA CSD** Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) at a rate not exceeding 5.61 mills for current expenses, for 5 years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.
4. **HUDSON CSD** Proposed Tax Levy (Additional) at a rate not exceeding 5.9 mills for current expenses, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.
5. **NORTON CSD** - Proposed Bond Issue in the principal amount of \$27,505,239 to average 4.6 mills, maximum repayment period of 37 years, for constructing, furnishing, equipping, adding to, renovating, remodeling, rehabilitating, and improving School District buildings and facilities and acquiring, clearing, improving and equipping real estate for school purposes  
Proposed Tax Levy – (Additional) at a rate not exceeding 2 mills for financing of general permanent improvements, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.
6. **COVENTRY LSD** Proposed Tax Levy (Additional) to average 6.25 mills for the emergency requirements of the district, for 5 years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.
7. **HIGHLAND LSD** - Proposed Tax levy (Additional) to average 5.9 mills for emergency requirements, for 5 years, commencing in 2010, first due in 2011.
8. **MANCHESTER LSD** Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) at a rate not exceeding 8.5 mills for current expenses, for 5 years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.
9. **MANCHESTER LSD** Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) to average 1.47 mills for the emergency requirements of the district, for 5 years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.
10. **NORTHWEST LSD** Proposed Income Tax of 1% on earned income of individuals residing in the school district for 5 years, beginning January 1, 2011, for current expenses.
11. **REVERE LSD** Proposed Tax Levy (Additional) to average 6.86 mills for the emergency requirements of the district, for 10 years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.
12. **SPRINGFIELD LSD** Proposed bond issue and tax levy in the principal amount of \$33,725,000, for 38 years to average 4.38 mills to pay local share of school construction under the State Classroom Facilities Assistance Program.  
Additional tax levy at a rate of .50 mill for 23 years for maintaining classroom facilities.

13. **WOODRIDGE LSD** Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) at a rate not exceeding 2.03 mills for current expenses, for 10 years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.
14. **BARBERTON PUBLIC LIBRARY** Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) at a rate not exceeding 1.37 mills for current expenses, for 5 years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.
15. **STOW-MUNROE FALLS PUBLIC LIBRARY** Proposed Tax Levy (Replacement & Increase) at a rate not exceeding 2 mills for current expenses, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.
16. **AKRON-SUMMIT COUNTY LIBRARY** Proposed Tax Levy (Replacement) at a rate not exceeding 1.4 mills for current expenses, for 5 years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.
17. **FAIRLAWN 2-A** – Local Option – Shall the sale of wine and mixed beverages be permitted on Sunday by Sams Club 6404 in this precinct?
18. **FAIRLAWN 6-A** – Local Option – Shall the sale of wine and mixed beverages be permitted on Sunday by Marc’s in this precinct?
19. **MACEDONIA** Proposed Tax Levy (Replacement and Decrease) at a rate not exceeding 4.0 mills for current expenses, for 5 years, commencing in 2010, first due in 2011.
20. **CITY OF TWINSBURG** – Proposed zoning and development regulations amendment prohibiting the incineration of medical, pathological and anatomical waste.
21. **MOGADORE VILLAGE** \_ Proposed Income Tax Increase from 2% to 2.25%.
22. **NORTHFIELD VILLAGE A** – Local Option – Shall the sale of wine and mixed beverages and spirituous liquor be permitted on Sunday by Spennatos in this precinct?
23. **PENINSULA VILLAGE** – Proposed Charter Question – Shall a Commission be chosen to frame a Charter?
24. **RICHFIELD VILLAGE** – Proposed Electric Aggregation - Shall the Village of Richfield have the authority to aggregate the retail electric loads located in the Village of Richfield, and for that purpose, enter into service agreements to facilitate for those loads the sale and purchase of electricity, such aggregation to occur automatically except where any person elects to opt out?
25. **COPLEY L** – Local Option – Shall the sale of wine and mixed beverages be permitted on Sunday by Stoney Hill’s Station in this precinct?
26. **SPRINGFIELD TWP** Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) at a rate not exceeding 3.2 mills for EMS, for 5 years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011
27. **SPRINGFIELD TWP** Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) at a rate not exceeding 1.8 mills for FIRE and EMS, for 5 years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011
